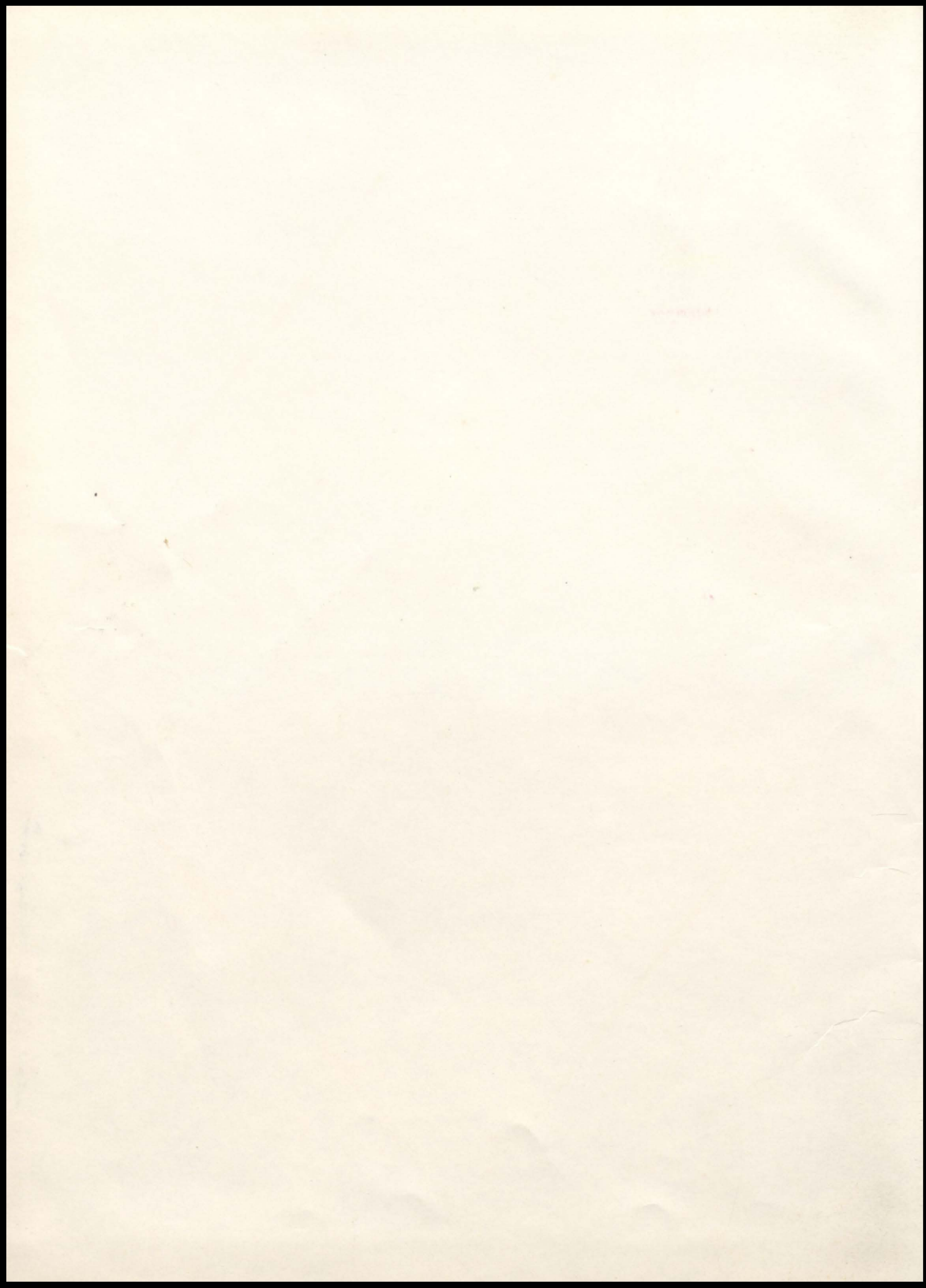

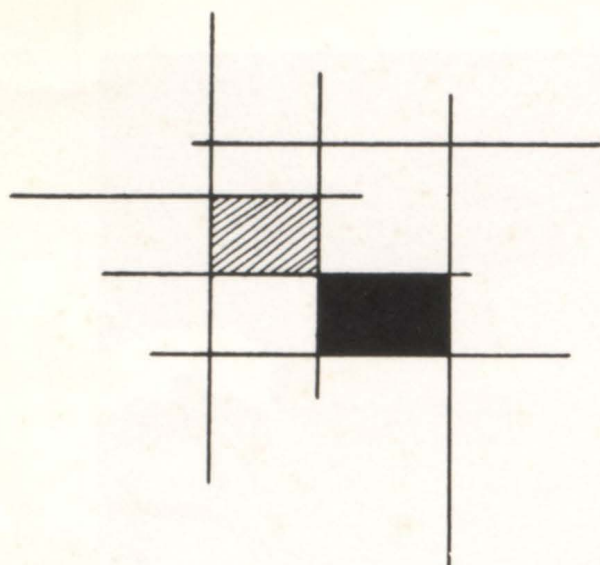

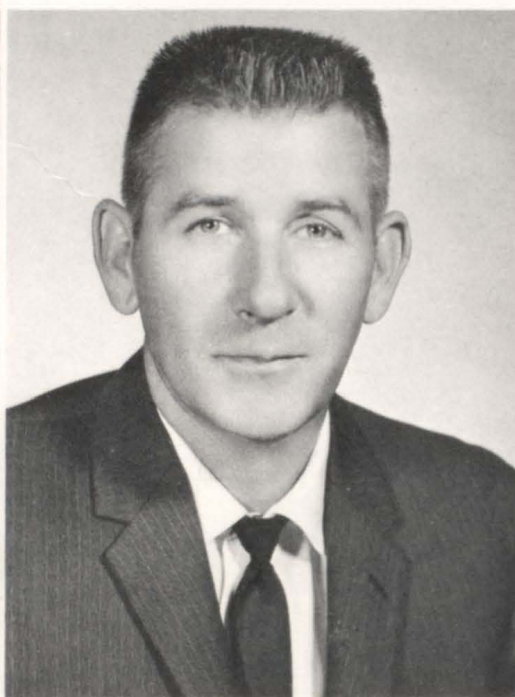
They Promote Unity and Cooperation
