


# Academics



# Agriculture

In Mr. Cantrell's various agriculture classes, students learn useful information related to that field. In Animal Science the class studies digestion, reproduction and animal life processes. Plant Science deals with different varieties of seeds and plants and also soil profiles are studied. In the Ag. Construction Class, various shopwork techniques are done under the instruction of Mr. Cantrell. In Welding and Electricity, the students construct gates and headshuts and are learning the principles of electricity. In Beef and Dairy Production, the judging techniques of beef and dairy animals are stressed. The class also learns about reproduction, nutrition, and the methods of achieving high productivity from the animals.







### Art

The art classes, taught by Mr. Marler, consist of Art I and Art II. Art I is offered to students from Grades 9-12. The basics of drawing, painting, sketching, pastels, and crafts are learned. In Art II, photography, as well as crafts, drawings, and the more advanced pastels, is taught. In photography, students learn the parts of a camera, about film, and how to develop beautiful pictures.











### **Business**





The business classes offered at Hartville High School help prepare students for later work, especially in the clerical and professional field.

The three classes taught by Miss Wilson are typing, shorthand, and Clerical Office Practice. In typing, students are taught correct methods of typing business forms and letters. In shorthand and Clerical, the students learn the basic functions of an office.

General Business and Accounting are taught by Mrs. Colton. In General Business the students are taught the fundamentals of different areas in the business world. Accounting students learn to keep records and other business finances.





# **English**





Mrs. Dryer taught English I, English II, Word Study, Speech, and Drama. English I students studied grammar, and they expanded their vocabulary through weekly vocabulary tests. They also studied ROMEO AND JULIET. The students in English II reviewed their grammar and wrote many compositions. The Word Studies class was introduced to the proper usage of a dictionary. By studying words and many spelling rules, these students were helped to understand the spelling of words.

The speech class studied the correct way to give and to write speeches. The drama class studied stage acting.





# English and French

English classes under the direction of Mrs. Reed were Poetry/Great Books, Short Stories/American Novels, and Appreciation of Literature. Mrs. Reed also taught French I.

Students taking Poetry learned how to apply the different elements used in writing good poetry, such as, similies, metaphors, and personifications.

In Great Books, students were given many interesting books to read. After the book had been read and a test taken over the contents of the book and also the author, they were given a subject from the story in which to write a composition.

Students in Short Stories/American Novels read many stories which were discussed in class.

Students taking Appreciation of Literature, a college oriented class, were taught to survive, function, and excel in college English. They were taught the background of the English language and the basics of good manuscript writing.

In French, Madame Reed not only taught her class how to speak French, but also many of the customs of the French people. Near the middle of the year, Madame Reed cooked a French meal for her class.







### Home Economics

The Home Economics Department is comprised of several Classes which prepare students for many aspects of everyday living. The instructor of these important courses is Mrs. Nelson. Home Economics I gives the student insights to the basics of sewing, foods, and nutrition. Personal culture and clothing deals with one's personal appearance and different aspects concerning clothing. Family relations and child care deals with different views of dating, marriage, and parenthood. Foods and family health students practice meal planning and betterment of family health. Bachelor living is for the male students and consists of instruction in the areas of sewing, food, nutrition, and family relations. Students gain much from this department.

### **Industrial Arts**

All students are given the opportunity to exhibit their skills by entering projects in the Summit Conference contest. Joel Cravens was awarded "Best of the Show" for his rocking chair. Jan Rippee won a blue ribbon for her desk.







### **Mathematics**

The basic math class involved a thorough review of the "basics," while the Algebra I class solved equations and graphed ordered pairs. In geometry, students learned to work proofs by applying theorems. Algebra II consisted of a small group of six students, who, in addition to the regular assignments, did some interesting work with biorhythms.

Plato once said "Let no one ignorant of geometry enter my door." However, it was fortunate for the math students that Mrs. Brown's door to knowledge was open throughout the year as she guided her basic math, algebra, and geometry students to better learning experiences.







### Science



Science students learned a great deal under the instruction of Mrs. Miller this year. The Physical Science class studied a brief look at both Biology and Chemistry. The Biology I class studied beginning Biology while Biology II students studied it in more detail. They also spent some time in lab work. The Chemistry class spent the year doing chemical problems and lab work. Mark Dixon, for the third year, won Grand Prize at the Rolla Science Fair.





### Instrumental Music







Under the direction of Mr. Stubenrouch, the band worked hard on marching and concert material.
