Math

Without the help of Mrs. Brown, the math students couldn't get very far with their problems. The courses included are Basic Math, Algebra I and II, and Geometry.

Basic Math deals with a review of the basic fundamentals while Algebra I deals with solving equations and working with ordered pairs. In Geometry, the students work proofs by applying theorems. The music department, under the direction of Miss Compton and Mr. Wheatley, has worked hard this year.


The band won First place in the Mansfield Christmas parade and the Hartville Christmas parade.
