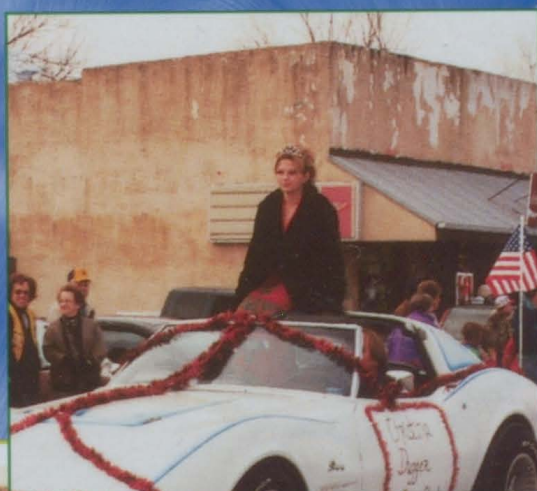

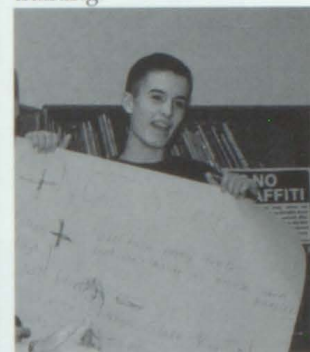

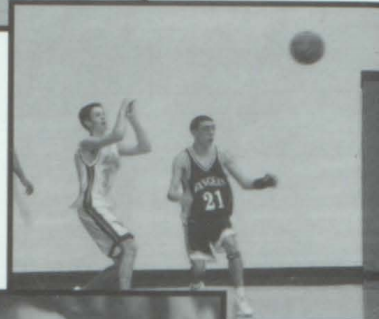

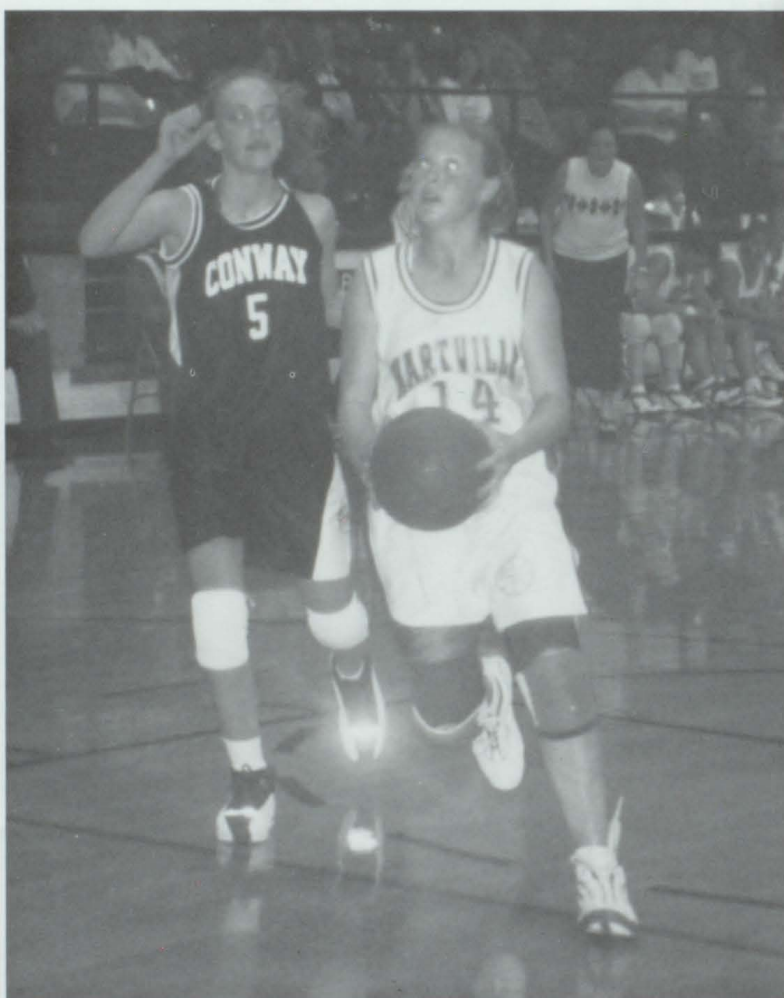

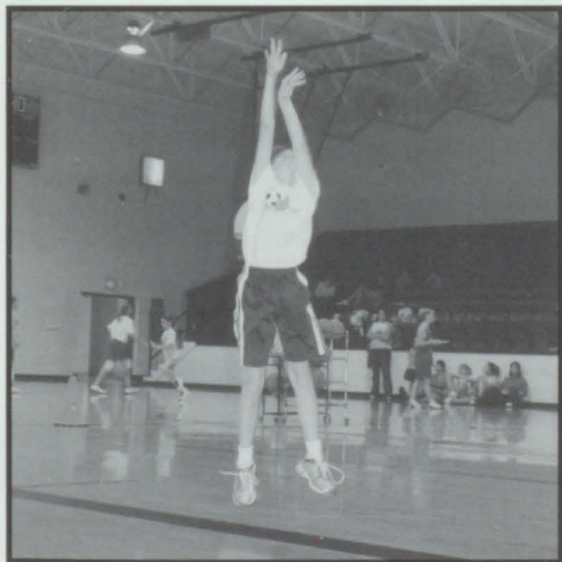

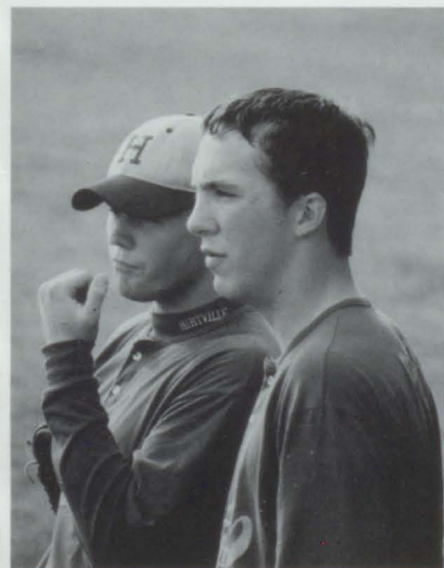

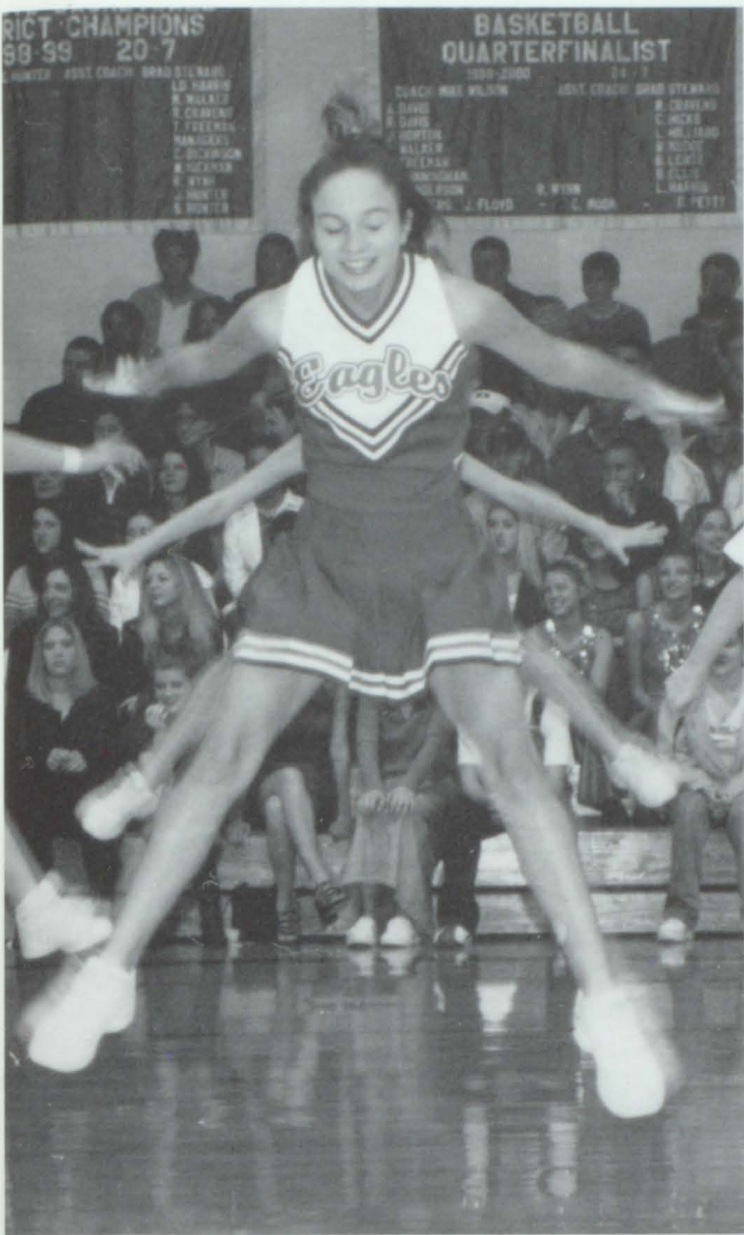

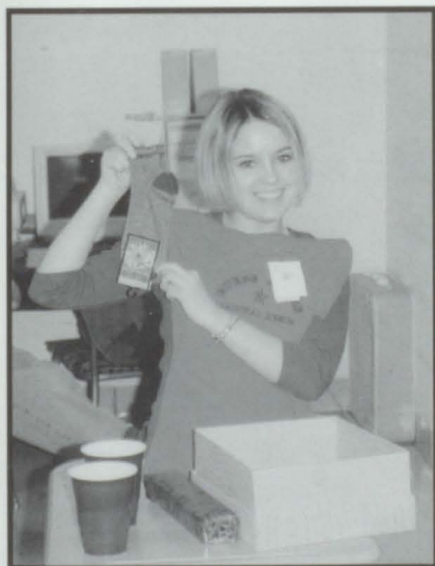

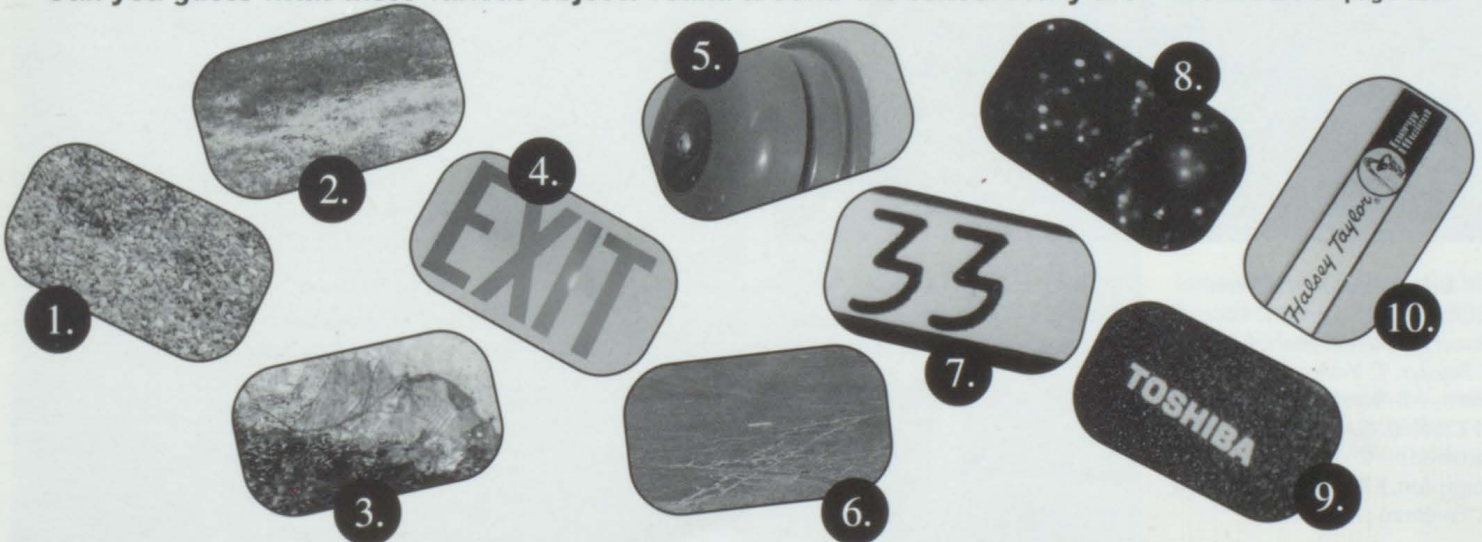

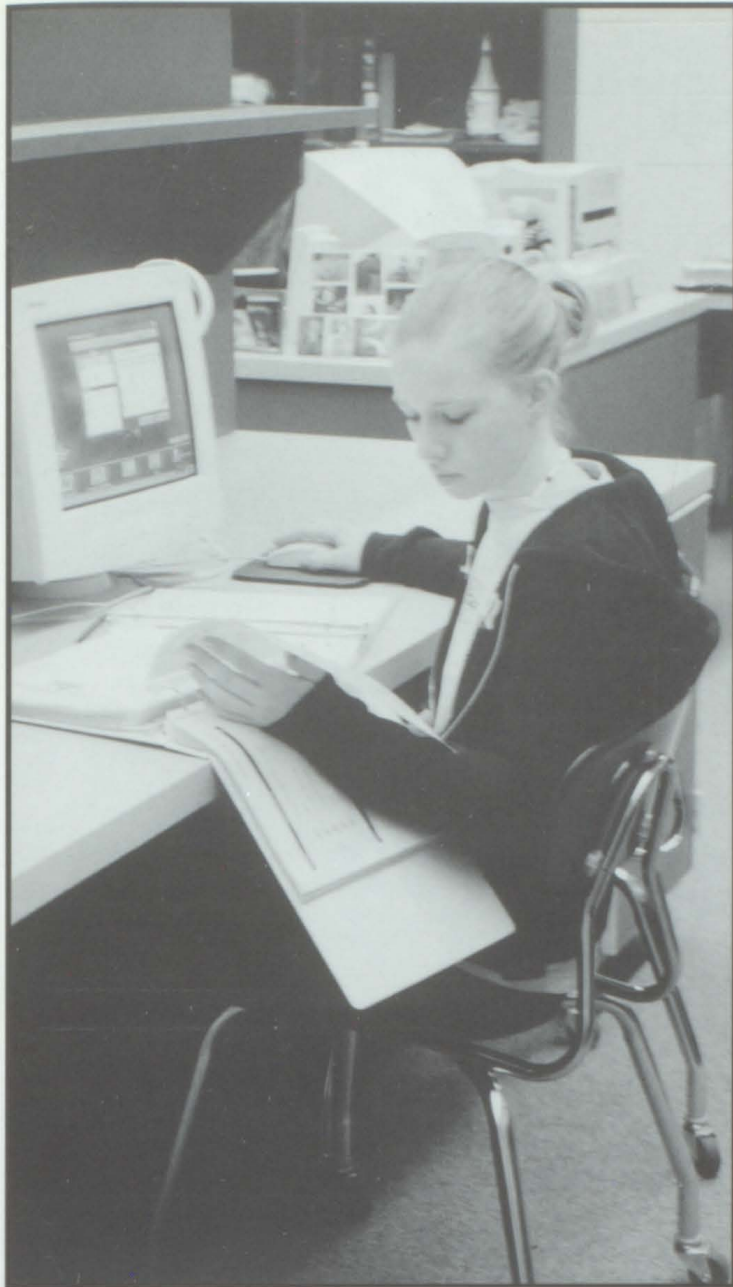

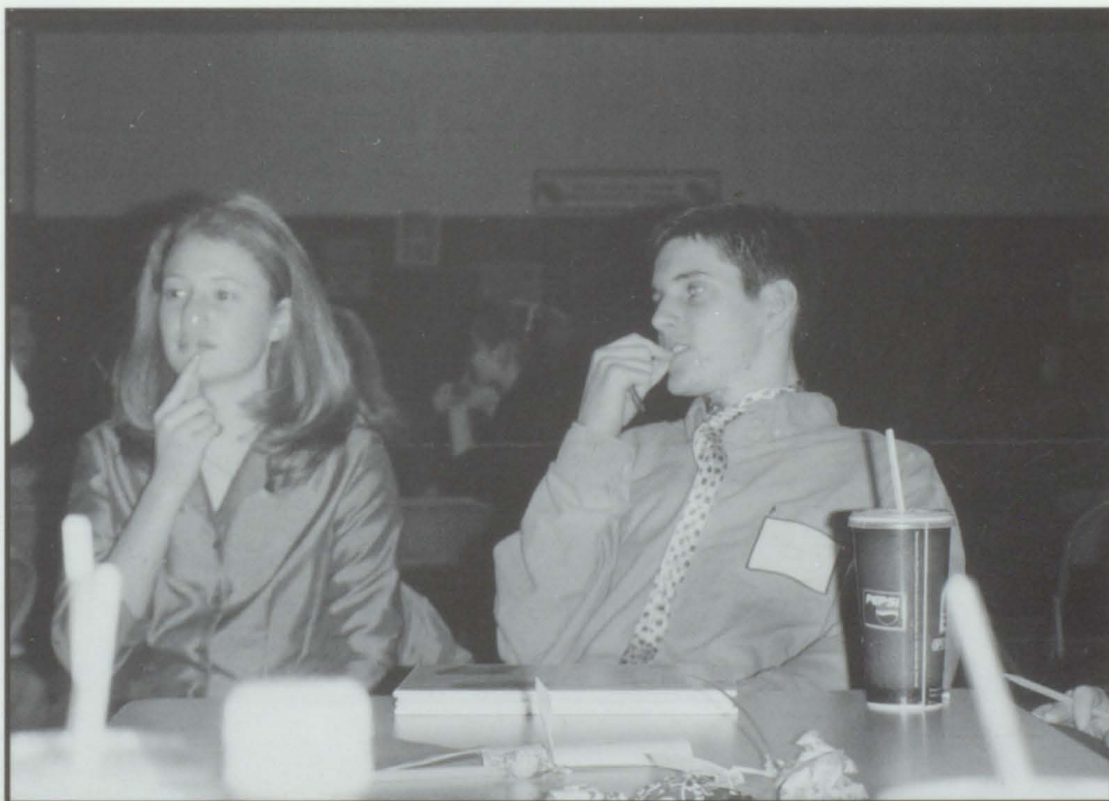

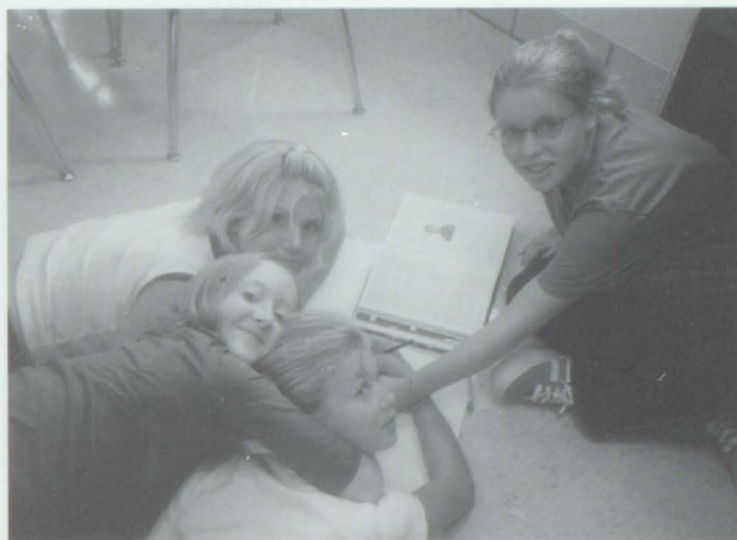

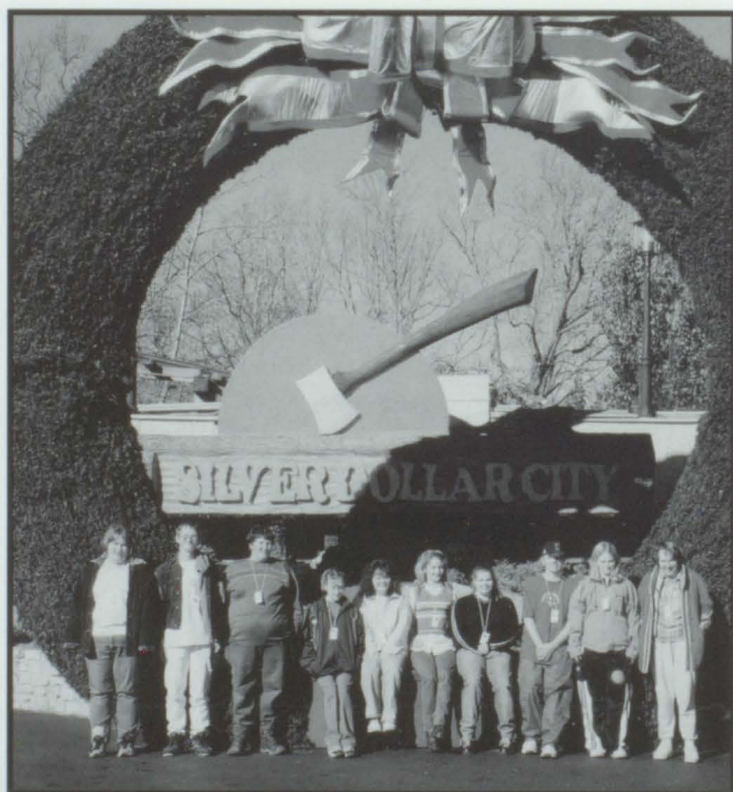

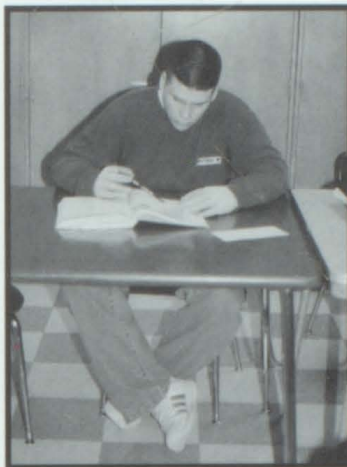

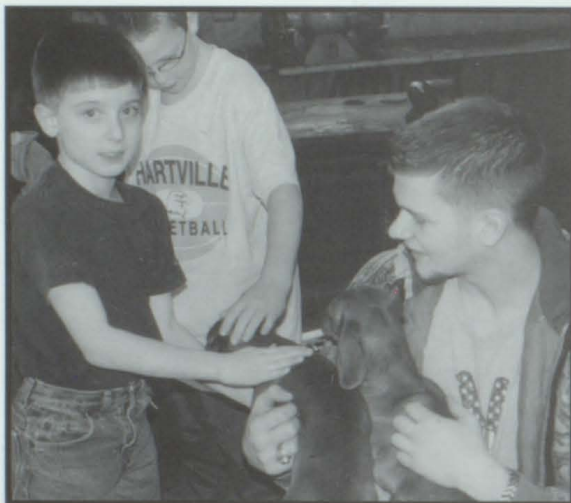

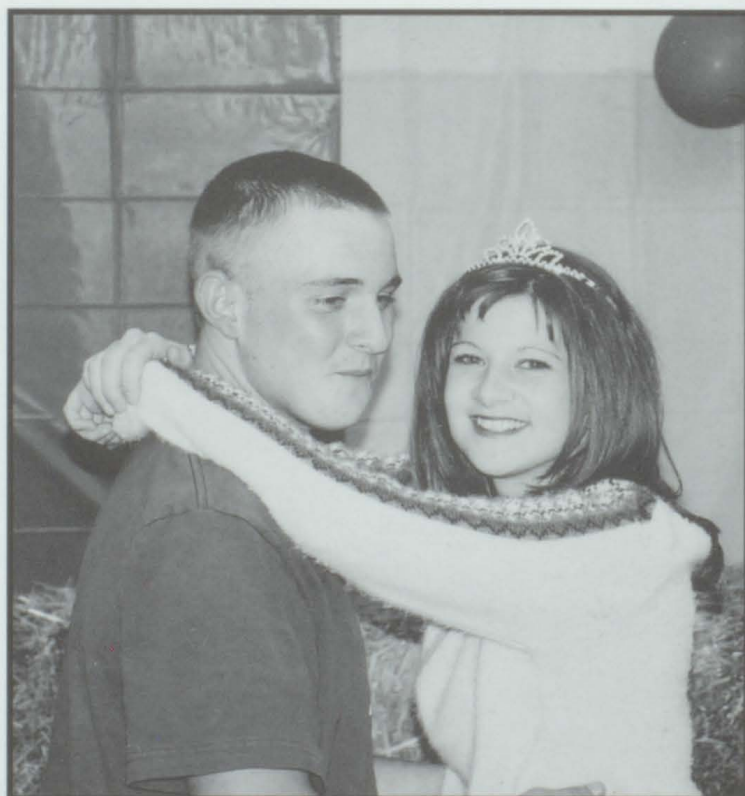

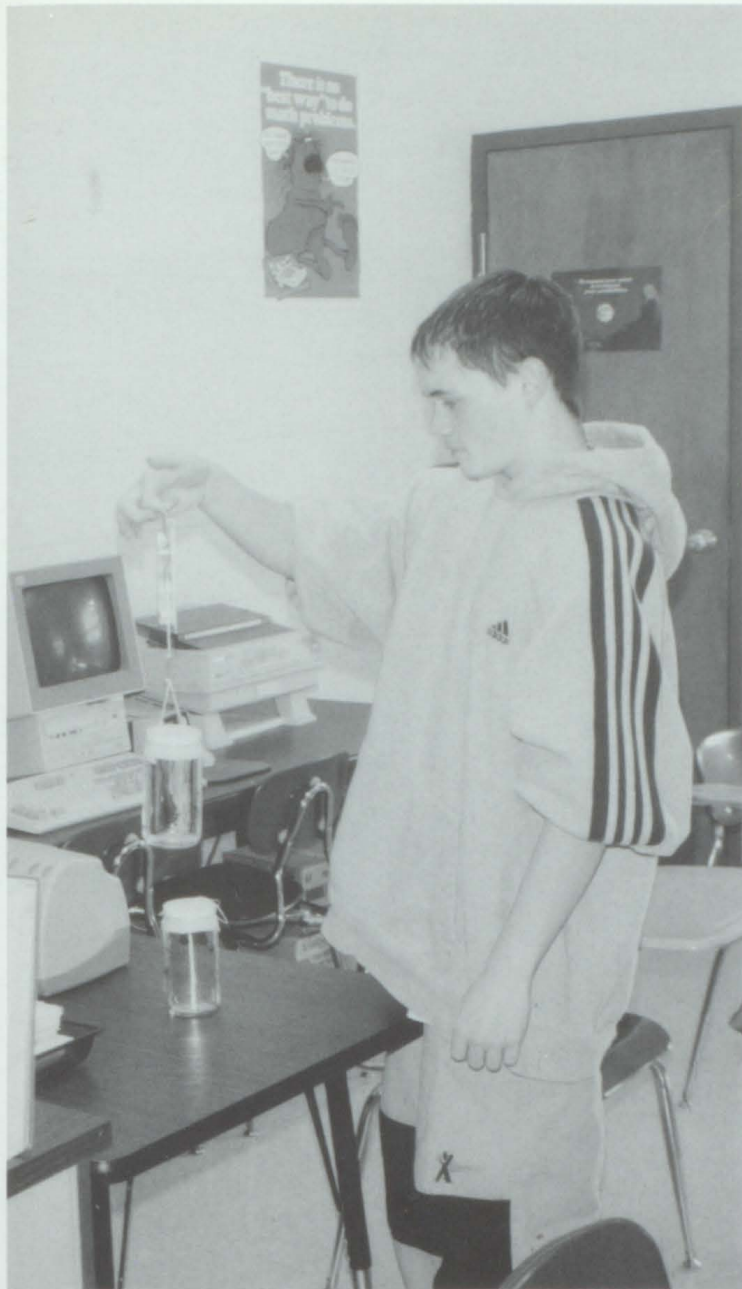

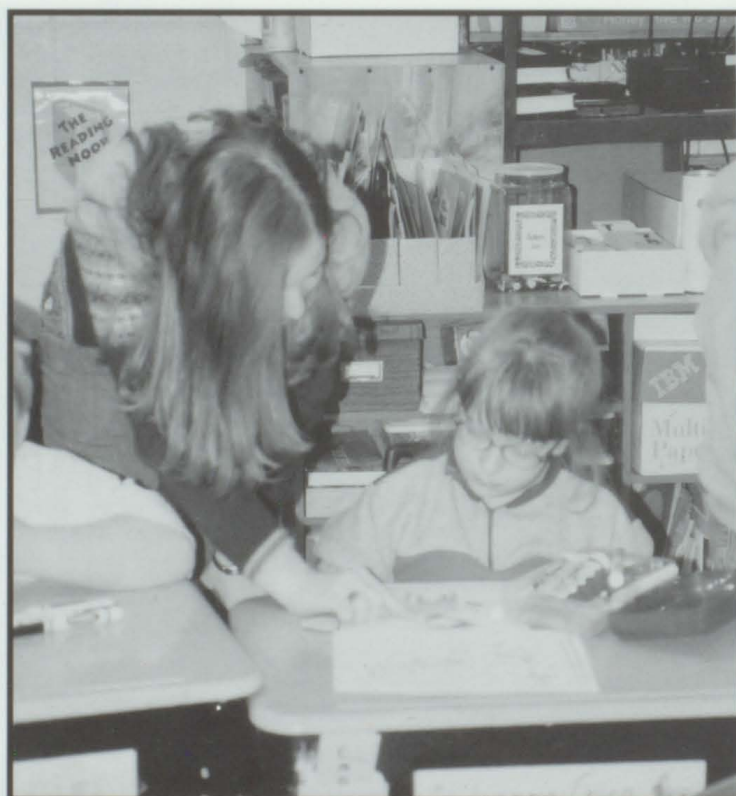

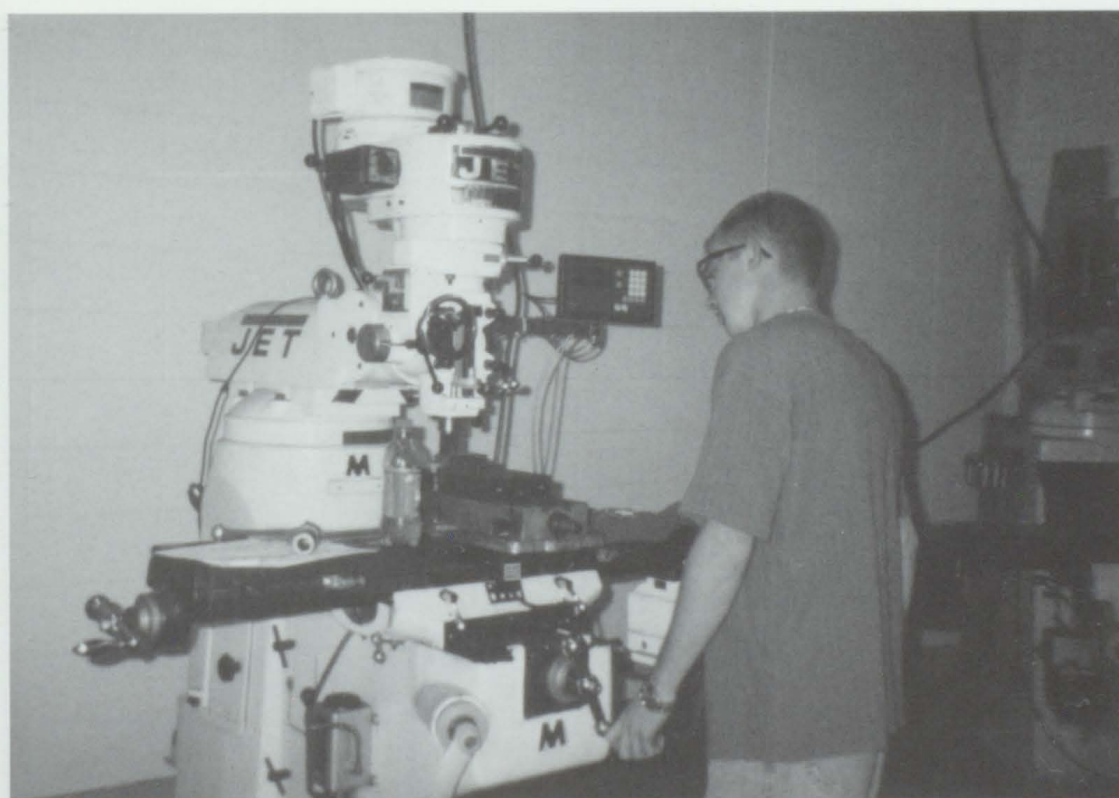

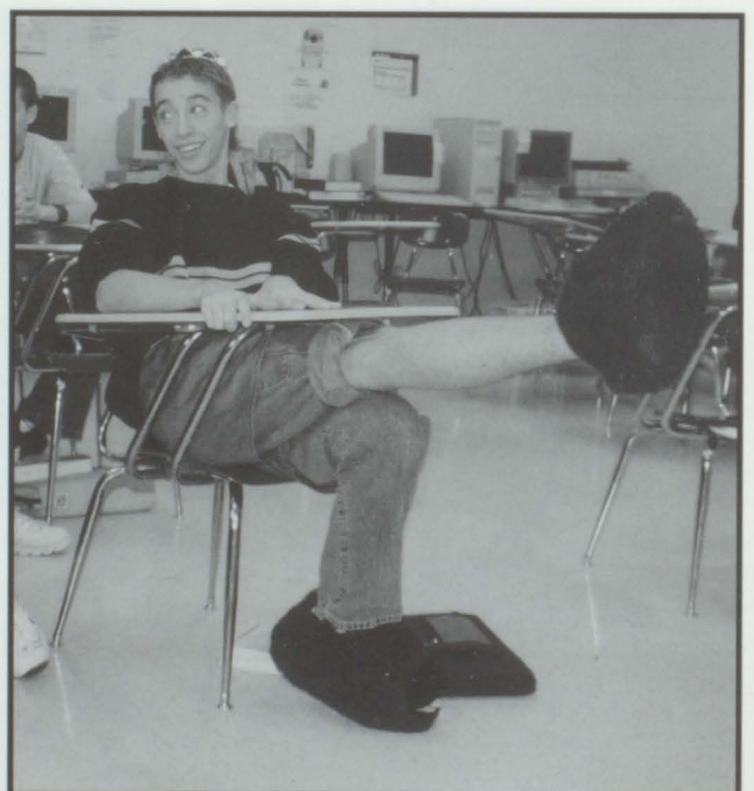

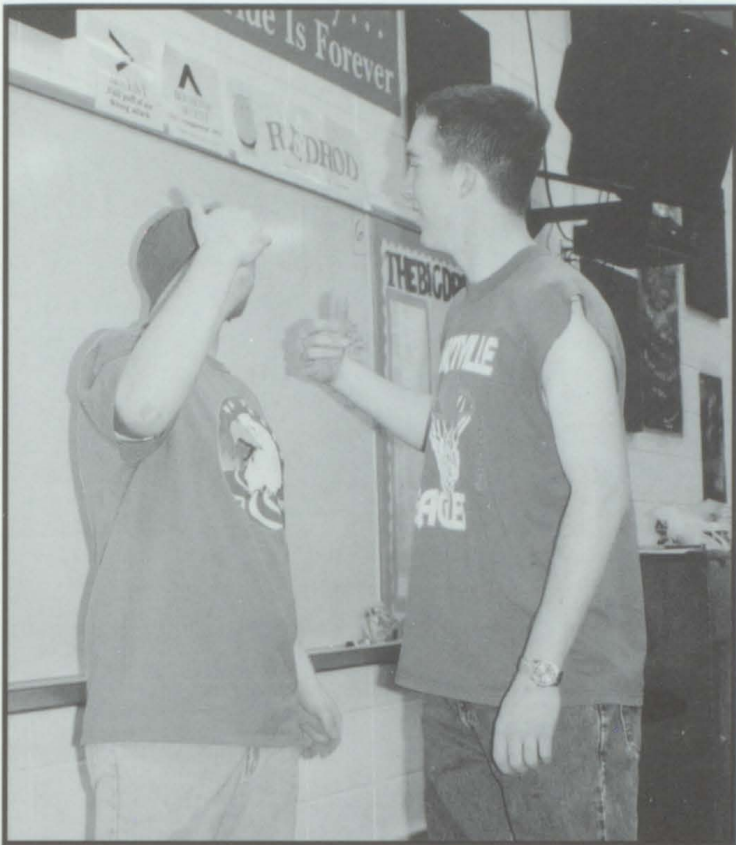

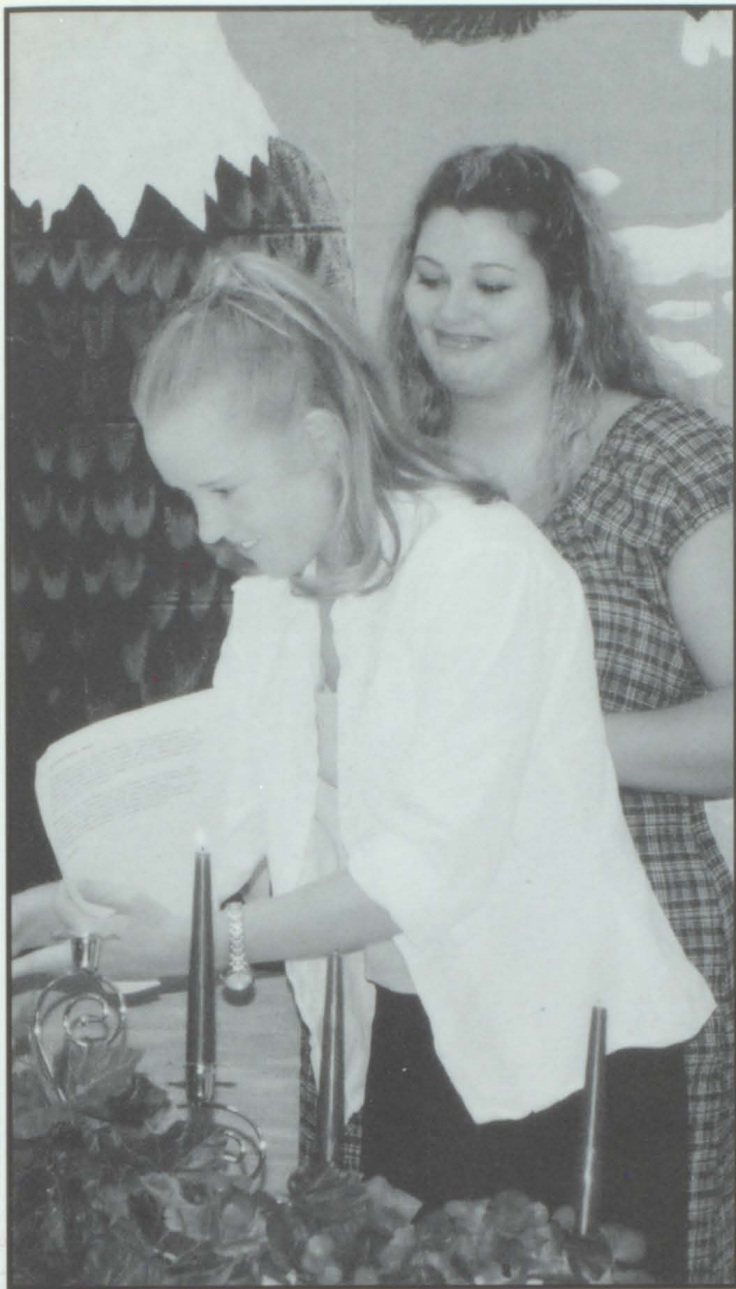

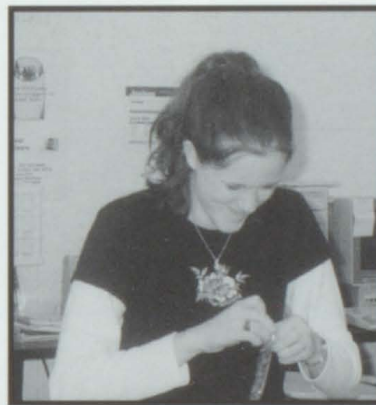

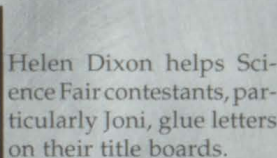
Helping Hands

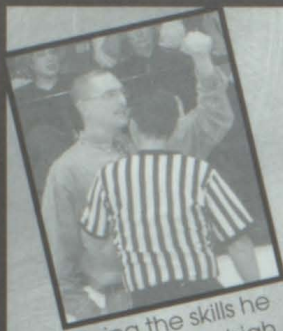
HHS History Club to Relocate Log Cabin
