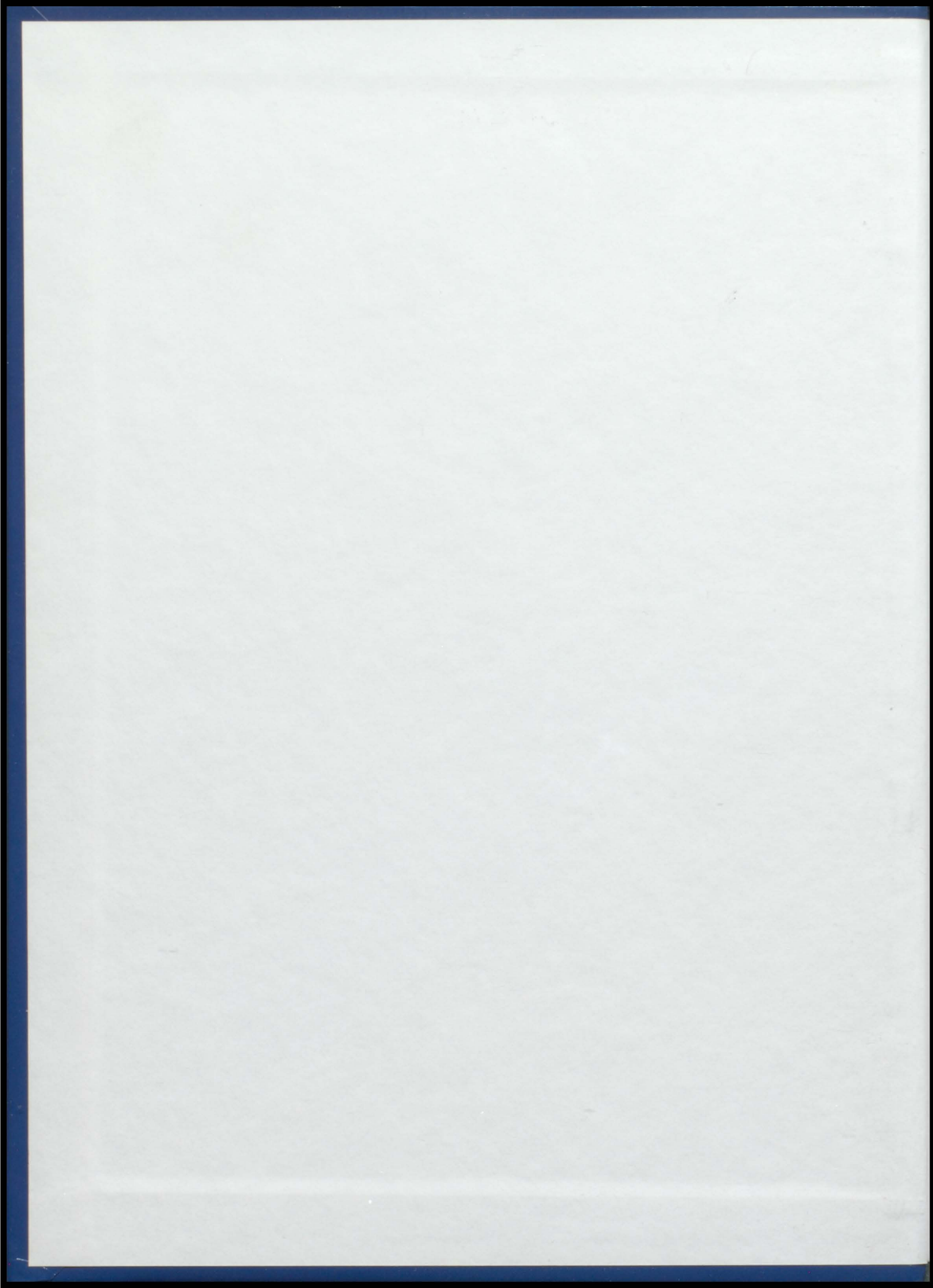
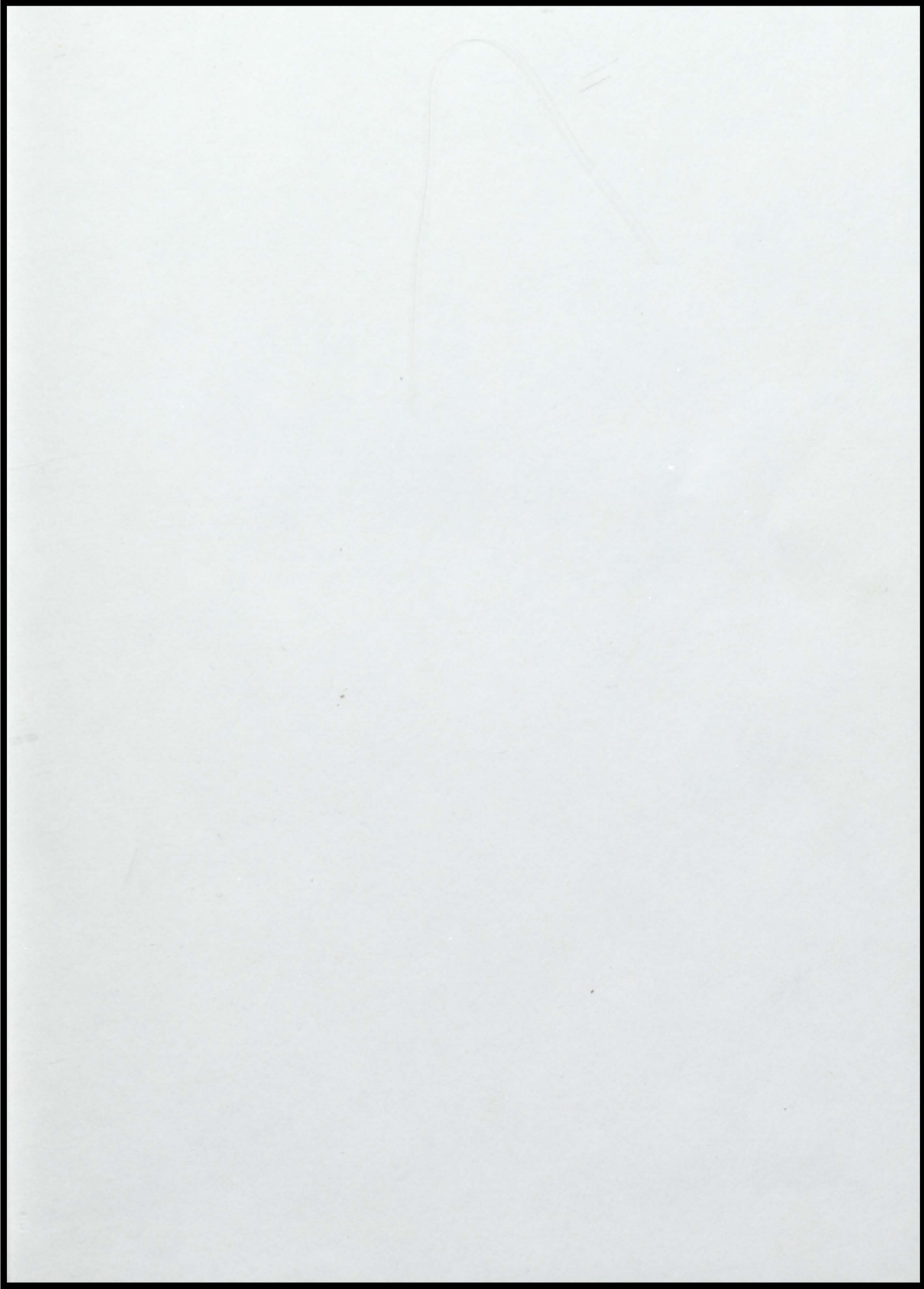
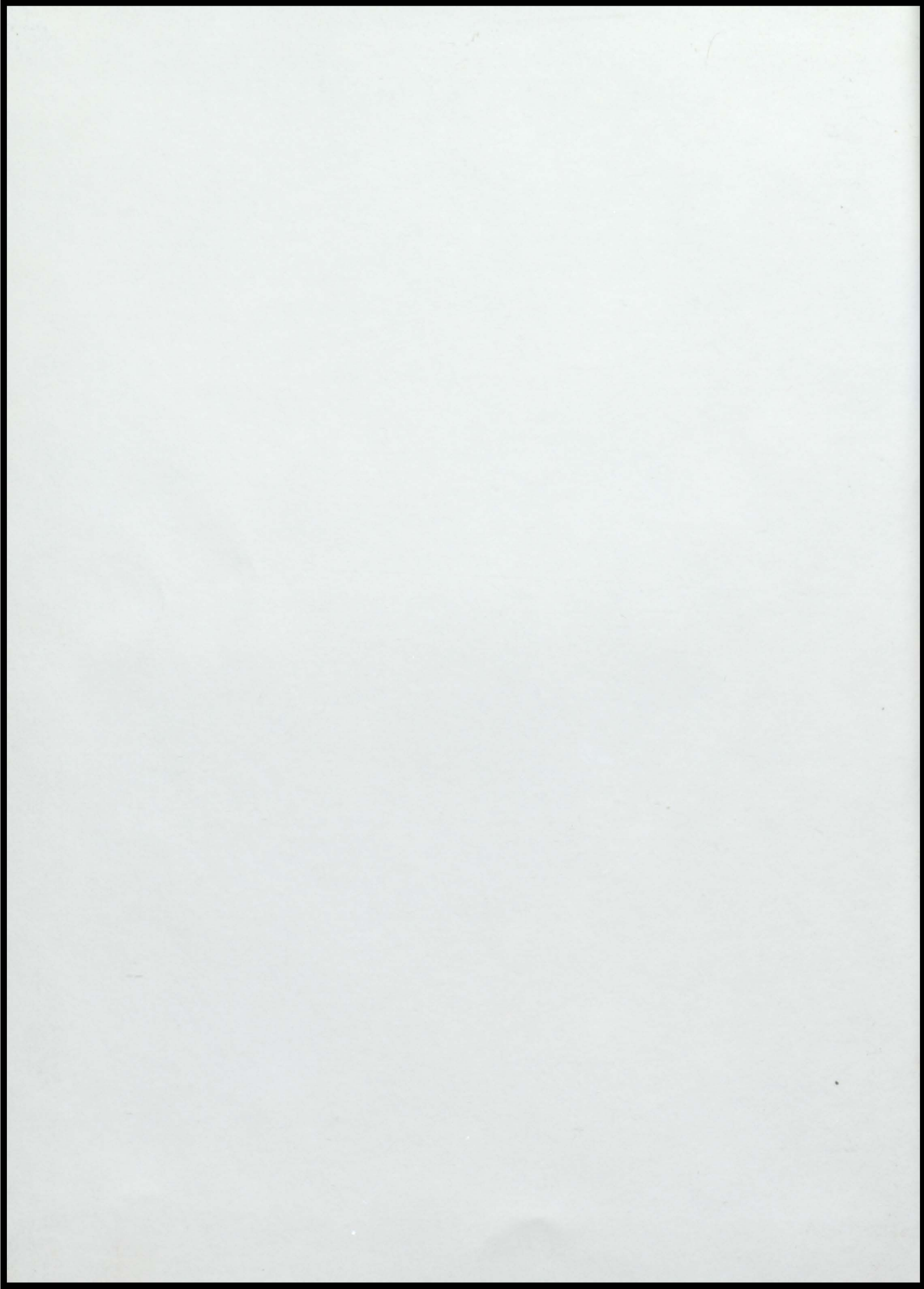

Wright County, in the Ozark Highland of Missouri, lies in a region ceded the U.S. by the Osage Indians in 1806. The first white settlers, mainly from Tennessee, came in the 1810's. The county, named for Senator Simeon Wright of N. C., was organized in 1814. Hartville was laid out as county seat the same year. The town name was probably derived from Hartsville, Tenn.

During the Civil War, Hartville was the scene of a bitter day-long battle, January 22, 1862, in which some 2,500 Confederates under Gen. John S. Marmaduke, encountered about 1,000 Federals from Gen. Fitz Henry Murray's command. Victory was claimed by Union's side, but Confederate loss was heavy. Joseph D. Shelby (later general) and Joseph C. Porter who was mortally wounded.

South Dixie, in southern Wright County, flows north to the Missouri and south to the headwaters of the Gasconade River. At Cedar Gap, the Missouri reaches 1,655 feet.

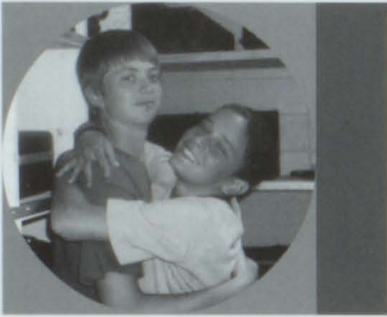

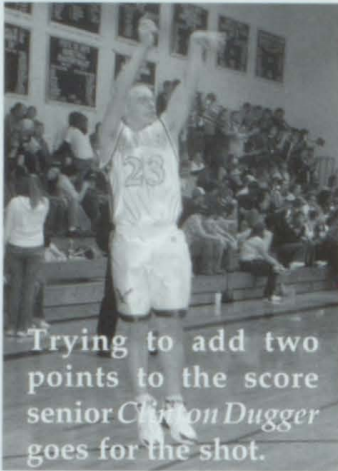

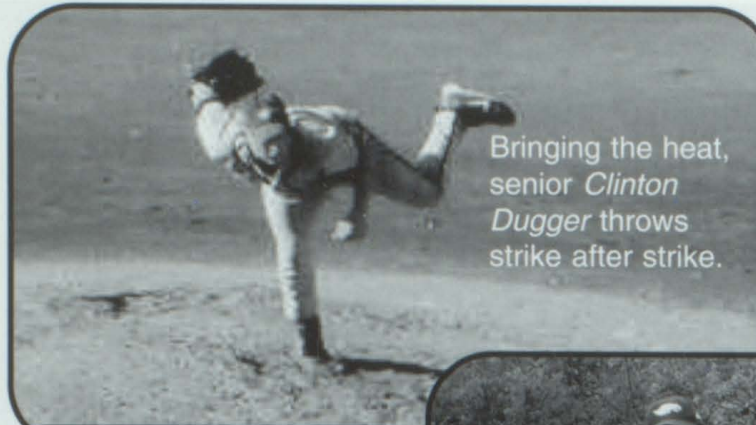

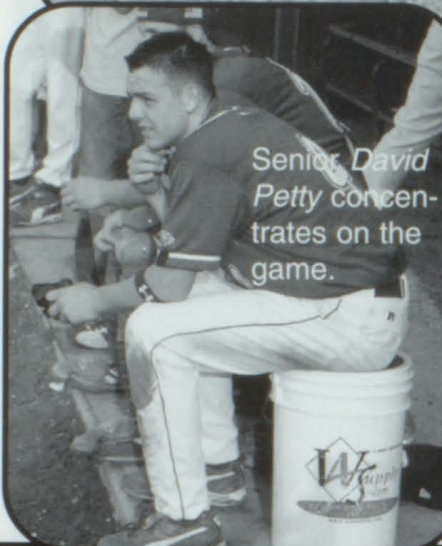

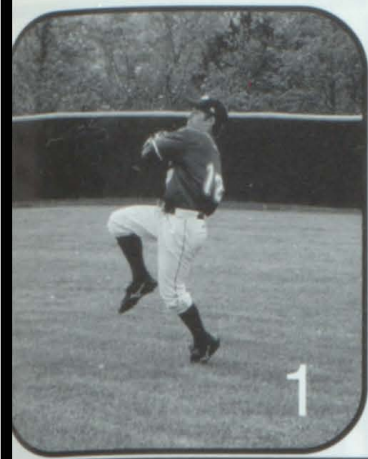

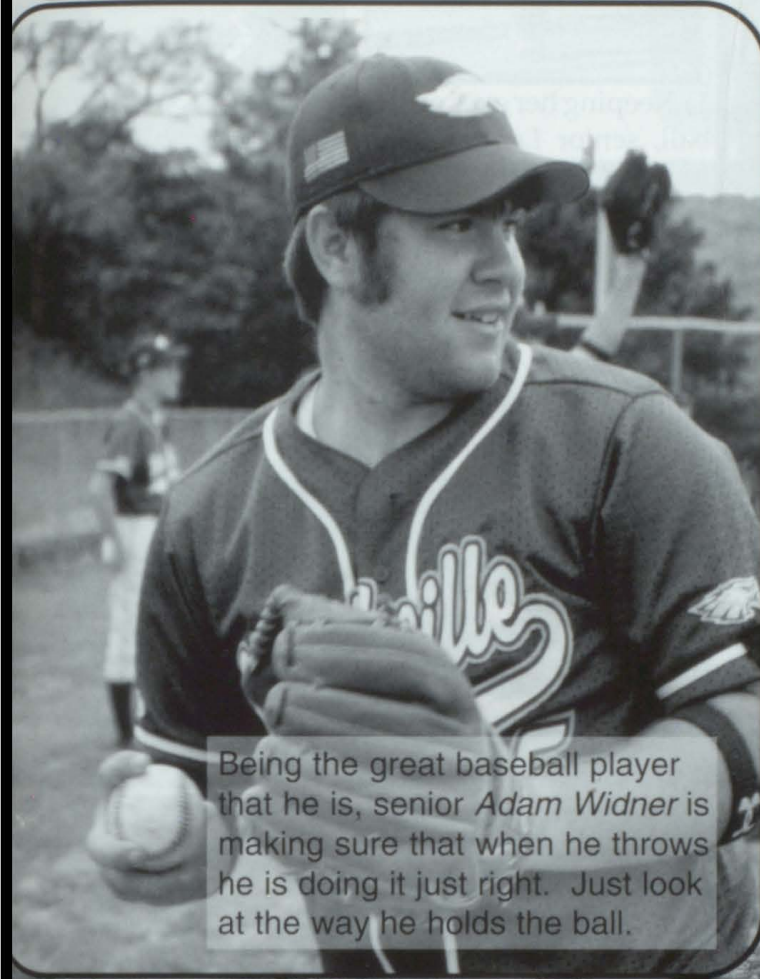
