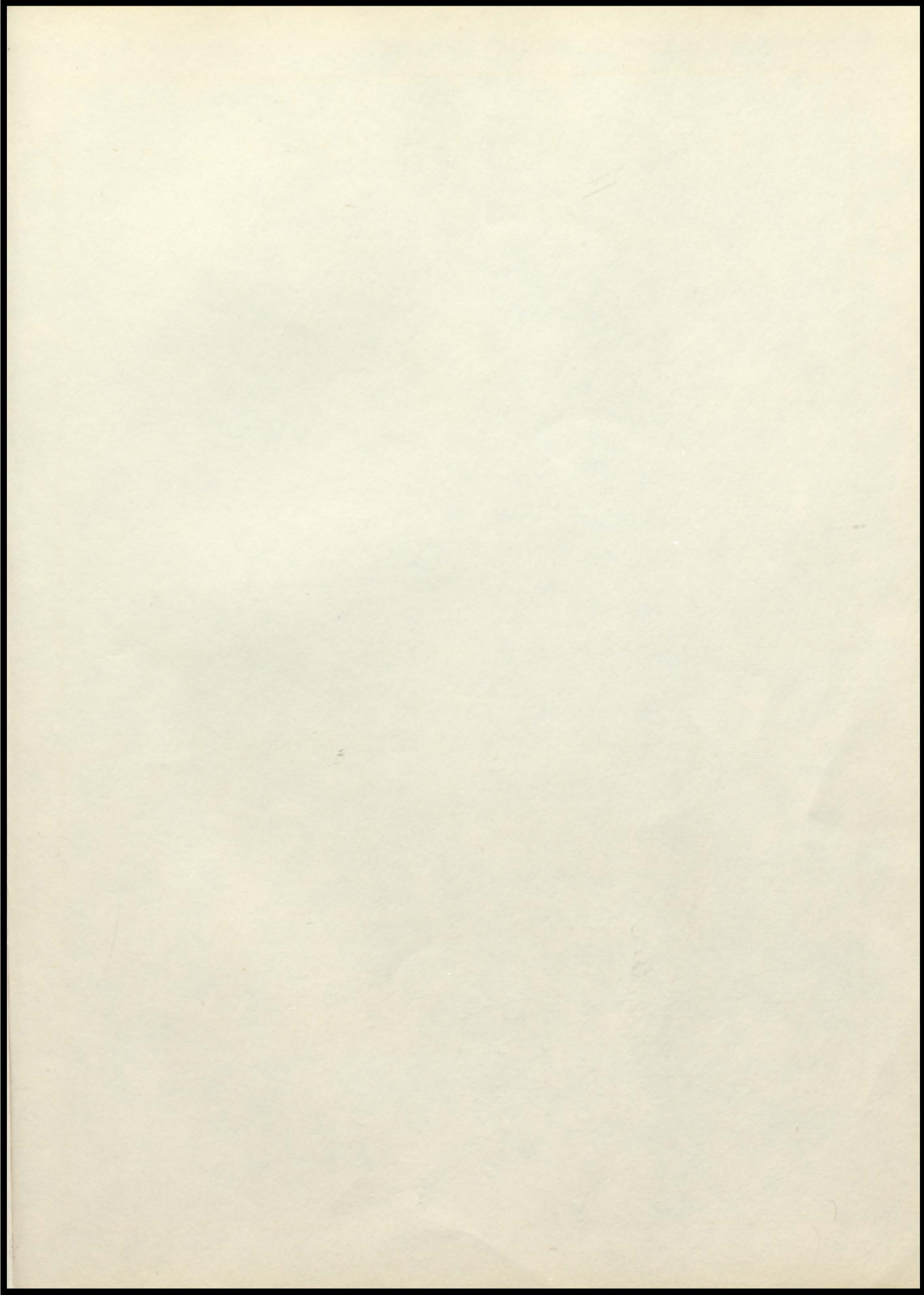


Superintendent's Message

With the continued cooperation of students, teachers and patrons, the Mansfield School District can continue to have a good school.

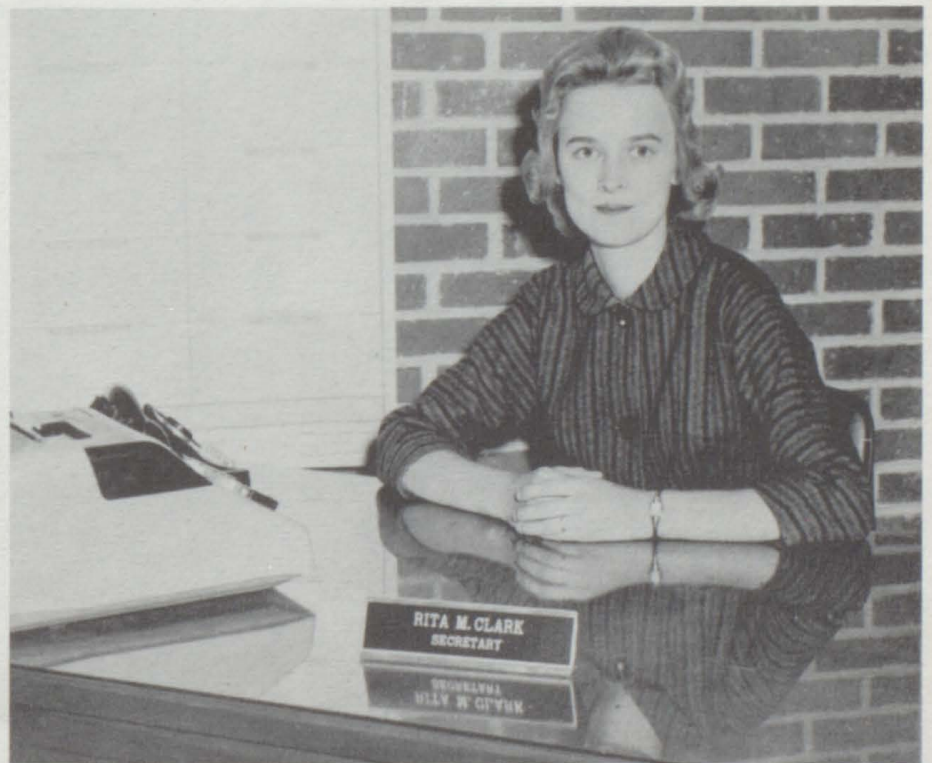

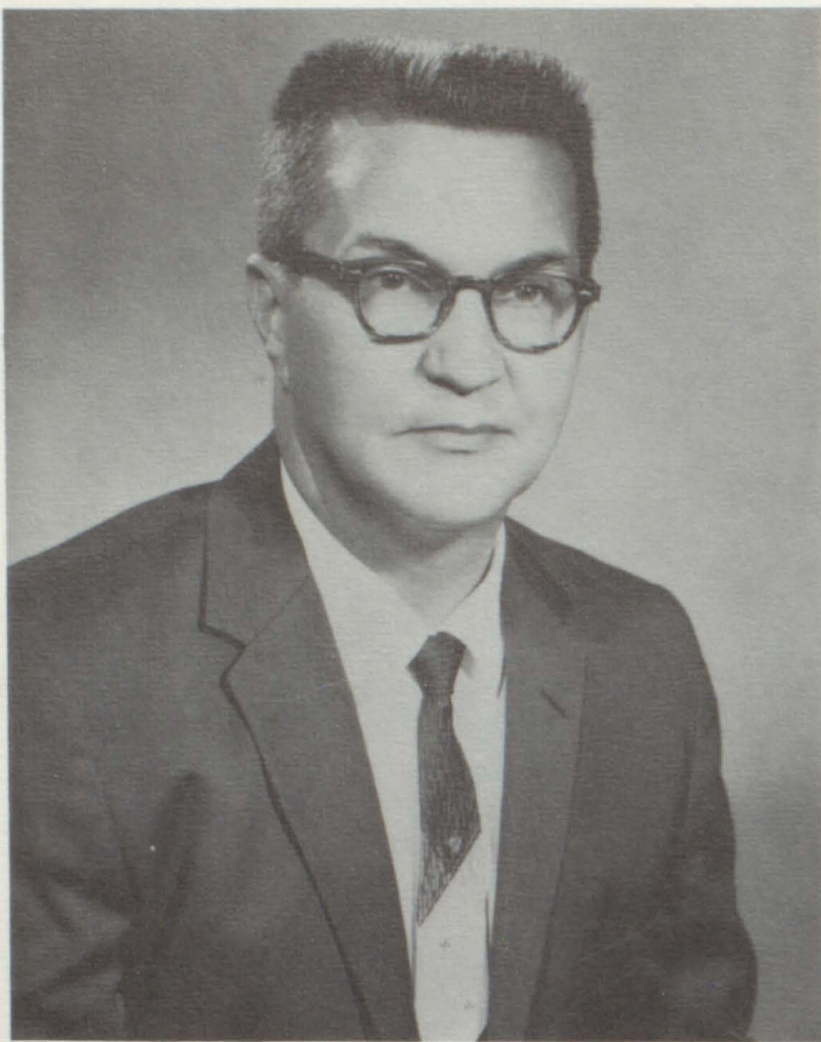

Thanks to those teachers, parents, and students who have made it possible for us to realize a part of our high hopes for educational achievement here at Mansfield.

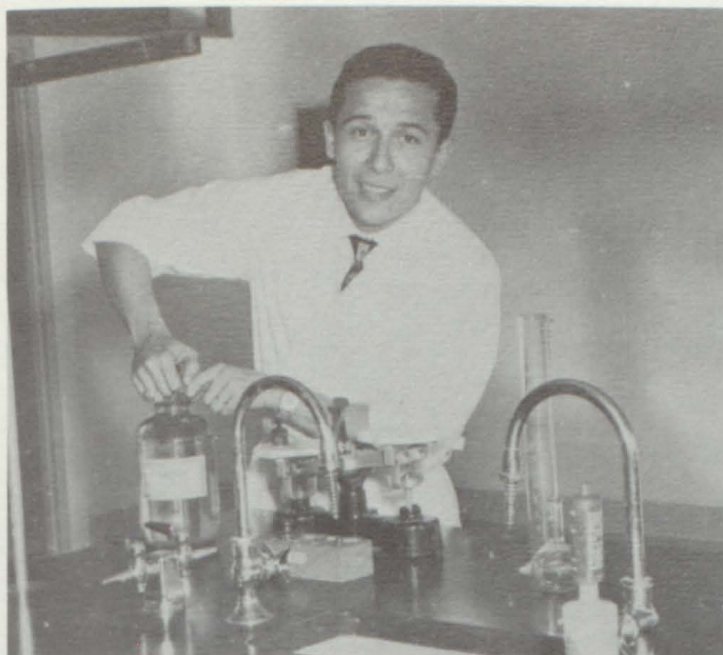

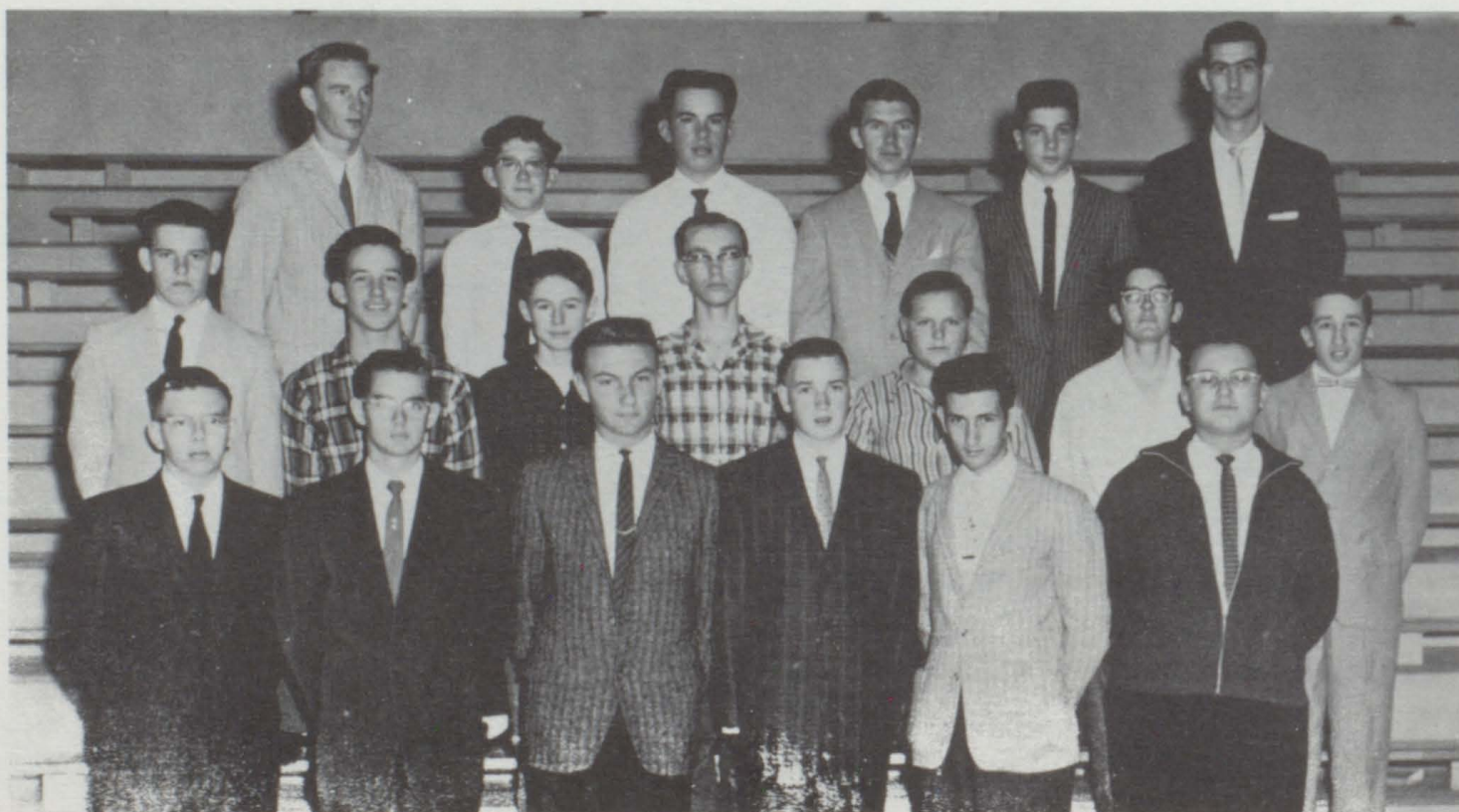
