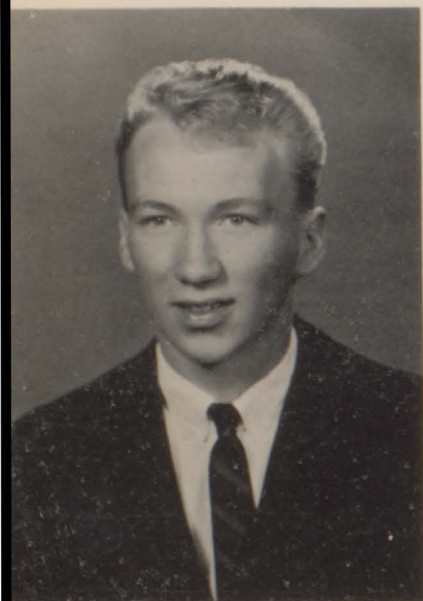
The class voted to purchase a large painting of a panther to be hung in the new gymnasium as a remembrance of the class.
